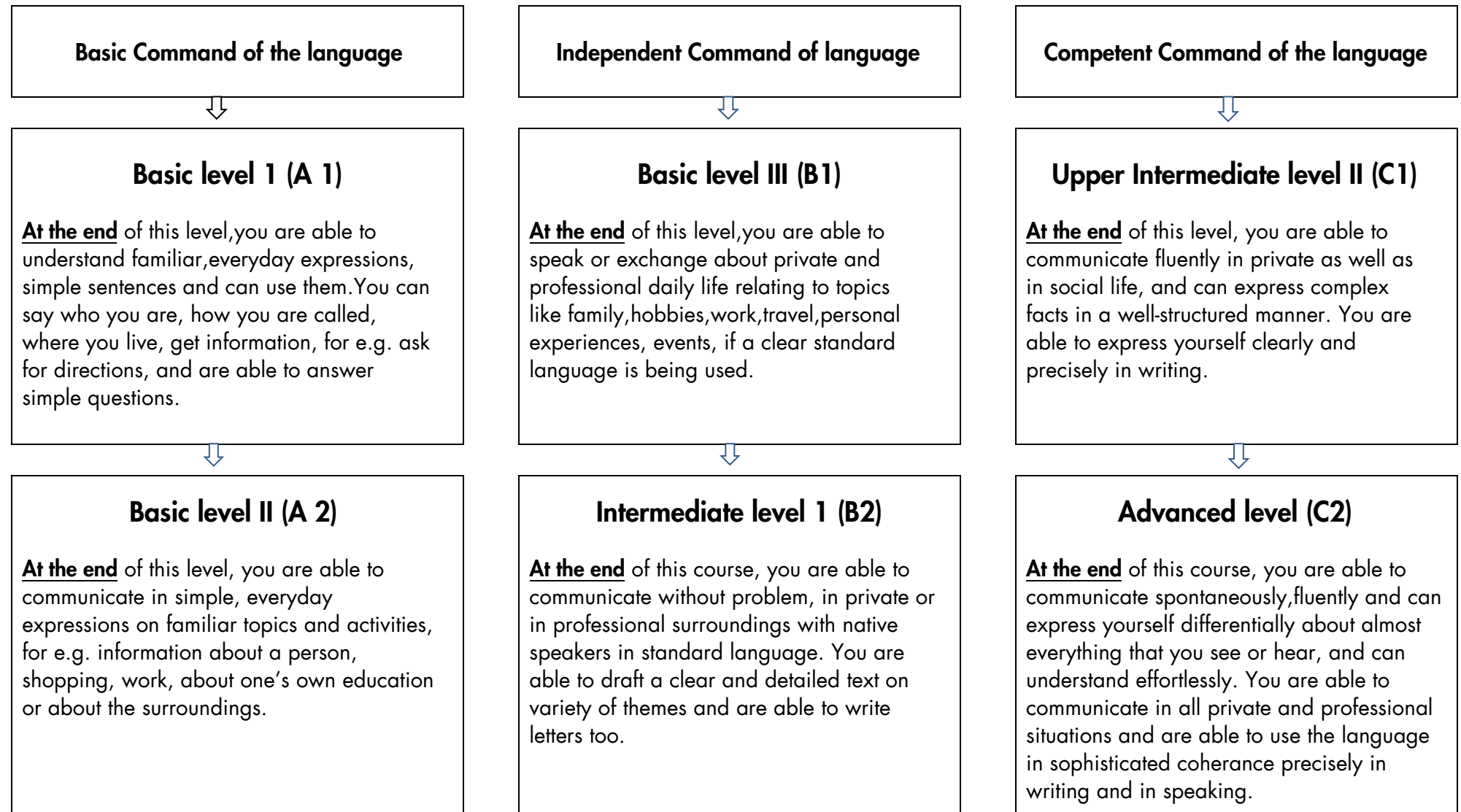


What are the language levels and the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages?

The language courses including the German language courses of the VHS orientates to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (GER), which is the common valid scale for language competence throughout Europe.

A1,A2,B1,B2,C1,C2 are the six language levels that describe what the learners can attain either by self-learning or by completion of a course. The following overview of the language levels can help you in your self-assessment of your linguistic proficiency and thus illustrates what you could learn in our language (including German) courses.



We offer language courses at A1,A2,B1,B2 levels. As a rule, no examination takes place after the end of courses.

On payment of EUR 2,50 fee, a certificate of attendance can be attained. One can learn Arabic, English, French, Japanese, Spanish, and many other languages here at the VHS.

We offer German language courses at A1,A2,B1,B2, and C1 levels. In some of these courses, one can take an examination and attain certificate upon passing the exam.
